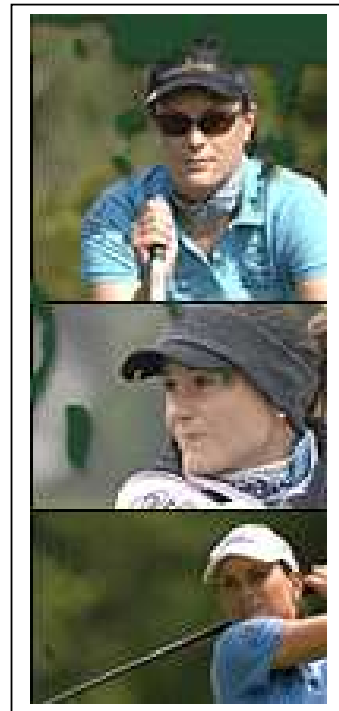


Ladies European Tour - September

One thing that certainly helped me this season was employing a professional caddy for a part of the season. It was excellent to have Gerald out there with me but it is a catch 22 situation. I would love a professional caddy every week on tour but the main issue is financing it. A good caddy doesn't come cheap but believe me; they can be worth every penny!

It was nice to have a years experience behind me. A good percentage of events are at the same venue every year and the familiarity of the same airports and hotels definitely make it easier for you to relax and focus on your golf, and obviously knowledge of the course is nice to have! With that in mind I'm already looking forwards to returning to Deutsche Bank Swiss Open played at the Golf Gerre Losone, the course was only outdone but the breathtaking scenery, certainly the most beautiful I've ever played in.

I've still got two events left to play in India and then Dubai, both in December. I'm working hard on my game now so hopefully I can finish the season on a high and then take that momentum in to next year and take another step towards where I know I can consistently be.
